EFFECTIVE INTERVIEWING IN A DEATH INVESTIGATION

The Effective Interviewing in a Death Investigation is a 24 hour P.O.S.T. Plan IV certified course for investigators entering into death investigation, or work as a stand-alone course for those wishing to learn more about the many facets of interviewing in death investigations. This course focuses on the core duties, skills, and knowledge that a newly appointed deputy coroner or law enforcement officer (responding to a death investigation) assigned to a Coroner Division will need to succeed in obtaining the necessary interviewing information to certify the manner of death on a death certificate. It provides the student with the tools, such as understanding effective communication, building rapport with a witness which can lead to on-going communication and exchange of sensitive information, the cognitive interview in a death investigation, understanding how religion and culture can affect people at the time of death or the investigation, and when Miranda is necessary for an interview to continue.
