Never leave your keys in your vehicle





Close and lock all windows and doors anytime you leave your vehicle



Do not leave any valuables in plain sight. Leave valuables at home, or conceal items out of sight, such as in the trunk or glove box of the vehicle



Never leave a vehicle running while unattended



When possible, park your car in a secured garage



When out, park in open, well-lit areas





Consider after-market products to secure your catalytic converter such as cables, clamps or shields
