Training Requirements for Sheriff's Department Personnel

This Training Bulletin serves as a quick reference document for the minimum training requirements for Sheriff's Department personnel. This bulletin lists training mandated by Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST), Standards and Training for Corrections (STC), the Sheriff's Department, and California legislation. Once you have completed your required POST or STC training, the department encourages you to attend additional training.

Your specific work location, employee classification, rank, and individual assignment will determine additional training you are required to attend and the timeline that you must follow for completion.
