



OCSD and OCDA *Brady & Massiah* Training

Review & Reconciliation Procedures

Initial Review and Reconciliation

- The Orange County District Attorney's Office (OCDA) and the Orange County Sheriff's Department (OCSD) will each exchange all training curricula currently operative for staff in its respective agency on the subjects of constitutional discovery obligations under the Due Process Clause of the 14th Amendment to the United States Constitution and suspect questioning under the Right to Counsel Clause of the 6th Amendment to the United States Constitution.
- The OCDA will submit its corresponding training curricula to the Advanced Officer Training Sergeant in OCSD's Training Division at AOT@ocsheriff.gov for OCSD review. The OCSD will submit its corresponding training curricula to the Assistant District Attorney supervising the Professional Responsibility and Training Unit of the OCDA (PRTU ADA).
- Each agency will submit its corresponding training curricula by completing an "OCSD and OCDA *Brady and Massiah* Training Review and Reconciliation Form" for each curriculum along with a copy of its corresponding training materials.
- The OCDA and the OCSD will each review the above-described training curricula of the other agency to ensure that the curricula is consistent with its own agency's policies, practices and training on the same subject matters as well as with current legal authority.
- If either agency identifies any inconsistency between its agency's policies, practices, or training and the training curricula of the other that agency will notify the other and the PRTU ADA and OCSD's Training Division will work together to reconcile each agency's training.
- Once the training curricula are reconciled, the PRTU ADA and the Advanced Officer Training Sergeant will each sign and date the "OCSD and OCDA *Brady and Massiah* Training Review and Reconciliation Form" confirming the training curricula review and reconciliation.

On-Going Review and Reconciliation

- If the OCDA or OCSD make any substantive change to any training curricula on the above described subject matters that agency shall complete the “OCSD and OCDA *Brady* and *Massiah* Training Review and Reconciliation Form” for each curriculum so modified and shall attach a copy of the corresponding modified training materials and submit it to the other agency for review as follows:
 - Any OCSD training curricula submitted to OCDA shall be provided by email to the PRTU ADA at Training@ocdapa.org.
 - Any OCDA training curricula submitted to OCSD shall be provided by email to the Advanced Officer Training Sergeant at AOT@ocsheriff.gov.
- If either agency identifies any inconsistency between its agency’s policies, practices, or training and the training curricula of the other agency that agency will notify the other and the PRTU ADA and OCSD’s Training Division will work together to reconcile each agency’s training.
- Once the training curricula are reconciled, the PRTU ADA and the Advanced Officer Training Sergeant will each sign and date the “OCSD and OCDA *Brady* and *Massiah* Training Review and Reconciliation Form” confirming the training curricula review and reconciliation.
- Each agency will maintain a copy of the completed “OCSD and OCDA *Brady* and *Massiah* Training Review and Reconciliation Form” in accordance with their respective agency’s retention schedule.
